In addition to the 8.0 credits of graduate level transfer work allowed for MBA students, JD/MBA students may take an additional 4.0 credits of transfer work to total 12 credits.
 In addition to the 6.0 credits of graduate level transfer work allowed for LAW students, JD/MBA students may take an additional 6.0 credits of transfer work to total 12 credits.

12 JD credits will transfer to the MBA degree.
 12 preapproved MBA credits will transfer to the LAW degree.*
 * Courses approved in the past include Operations Management, Financial Accounting, Negotiation Strategies, and Marketing Communications.
 These are examples of courses that are "substantially law related," and others may qualify.

Graduating JD students who have not yet had their MBA degree conferred and will not be cleared concurrently with their JD are ineligible to use the extra 6 transfer credits until the MBA has been conferred.

‡ The international requirement can be fulfilled by participating in a global enrichment or global immersion program (May/June or January), or by completing one of the following courses: MGMT 6305, IDSc 6465, MKTG 6072, or SCO 6081.
 ** MBA 6315 may be completed during any semester of the MBA other than fall year 1, but spring year 1 is recommended
 • MGMT 6465 (formerly HRIR 6465) may be completed during any semester of the MBA program other than fall year 1.

By the end of year four, each student should have completed 64 MBA credits and 88 LAW credits; both totals include 12 credits of transfer work.
 If students have completed the required 65 MBA credits (including the 12 transfer credits from LAW) by the end of year three they may apply for their MBA degree and attend commencement at that time.
