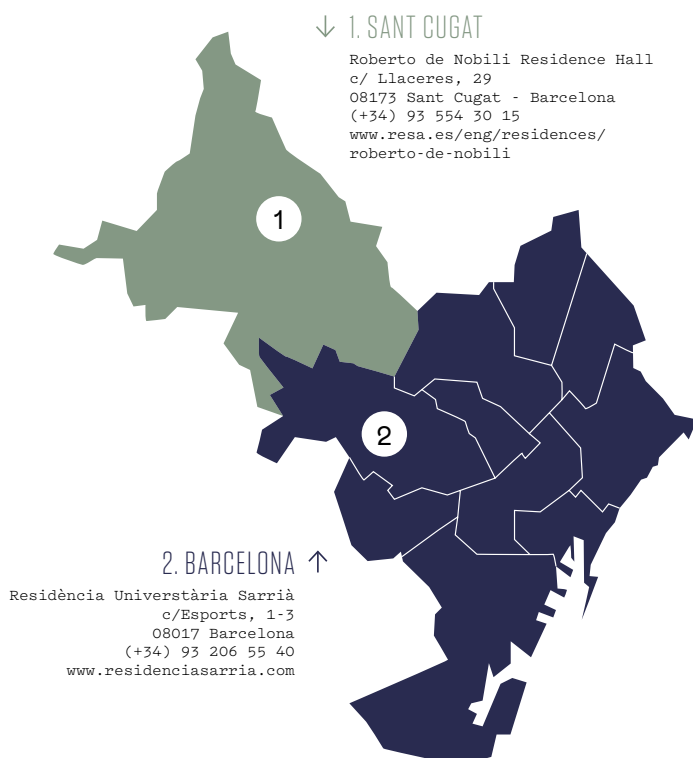

Campus location and housing options



Esade BBA Exchange classes take place on the Sant Cugat campus, about 20 minutes away from Barcelona.

Our institution does not provide housing for students. In Sant Cugat, the Roberto de Nobili Residence Hall is on campus and less than 5 minutes from your classes. In Barcelona, students can stay at Residència Sarrià, which is about 25 minutes from the Sarrià FGC railway station. There is also a shuttle bus that goes to Sant Cugat Campus twice a day for a fee. In addition to these accommodations, there are plenty of other housing options in Barcelona and the surrounding area.



FAQs:

Can I attend the programme for the full academic year?
It depends on the agreement between your home university and our institution.

How many subjects can I take and how many credits can I earn?

Incoming exchange students at Esade are required to take the following workload:

- Students from European universities: min. 27, max. 33 ECTS credits
- Students from non-European universities: min. 23, max. 33 ECTS credits

However, if the home university allows the student to take a lower amount of ECTS credits, Esade may consider making an exception. In order to consider this option, we would need to receive written approval from the home university exchange coordinator.

What are ECTS credits?

ECTS refers to the European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System. 1 ECTS credit corresponds to 25 working hours (maximum 10 contact hours + 1 feedback hour + 14 self-study hours).

What is Esade's teaching method?

At Esade, we expect active participation from our students. Teamwork is a very important aspect of most of our courses. Teams are made up of students with a diverse range of profiles representing different geographical areas in order to promote cooperation and participation with different points of view.

Is the orientation programme mandatory?

Yes. The orientation programme is a great opportunity to get to know the school, the city and the other exchange students.

Does Esade offer scholarships to exchange students?

Esade does not offer scholarships to exchange students. However, students coming to study in Spain may be eligible to apply to other grants offered by external institutions.

What is student life like on the Esade campus?

The Esade student community is lively, active and plural. Students in our programmes can participate in various activities through student associations.

Is it easy to commute from Barcelona to Esade's Sant Cugat campus?

Yes, Ferrocarrils de la Generalitat de Catalunya (FGC), a local train system, has several lines that connect Barcelona with Sant Cugat and run frequently.

How easy is it to travel during the exchange programme?

Travelling through Spain and Europe is quite easy. Cities in Spain and the rest of Europe are well connected by trains and flights.

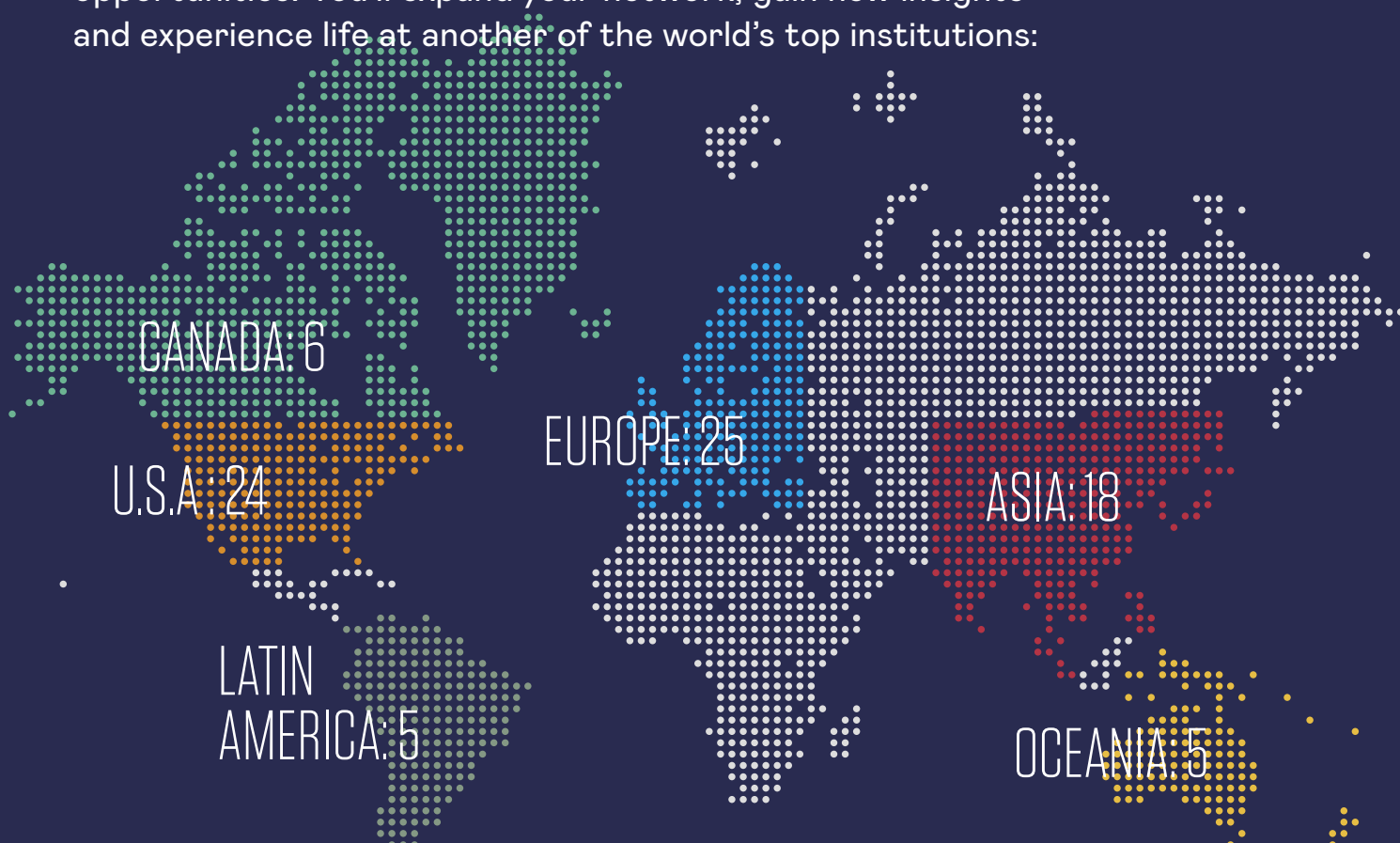
