



MILI 6997: VALUATION LAB, CAMBRIDGE, UK

In the Valuation Lab, teams of students complete a rapid market analysis of promising medical technologies and services to determine potential for success in a global market. Course project work exposes students to innovations and inventors. The outcome of this course is for students to learn to succinctly evaluate the value of a new medical industry technology or process by considering market size and potential, intellectual property, and return on investment. The program is a mix of class sessions, site visits and group work.

This course is offered as a collaboration between the Carlson School of Management and the University of Cambridge, Cambridge UK.

WHEN: July 13-24, 2025 on site in Cambridge UK
You will also be required to attend mandatory pre-departure sessions in advance of travel.
