## **Research Interests**

My research lies at the intersection of entrepreneurship, digital platforms, and gender gaps. I investigate the strategies used by entrepreneurial ventures to influence their legitimacy and to acquire resources, through digital contexts such as equity crowdfunding and online social networks. Additionally, I examine questions related to gender gaps in fields such as IT and entrepreneurship where women are a minority.

I explore these topics through the lens of organization theory and utilize randomized field experiments as well as rigorous econometric methods.

My work has been published in *Management Science* and the *MIS Quarterly*, featured in Forbes, and funded by the Kauffman Foundation and the Innovation Growth Lab at the National Endowment for Science Technology and the Arts (NESTA), UK.
