DISSERTATION RESEARCH

- My dissertation research examines interorganizational collaboration and performance from a macro perspective, integrating classic sociology theory with contemporary network perspectives. I am primarily interested in understanding the emergent properties and performance of whole networks, as opposed to individual outcomes of the constituent organizations. This work is motivated by my interest in interorganizational collaboration, particularly with regards to solving large-scale problems and Grand Challenges—arenas in which the greater good may not necessarily mean maximizing local performance. Therefore, through two essays, I study the network-level properties and performance of hundreds of networks of healthcare organizations in the era of the US Affordable Care Act. The first essay develops a new theoretical framework for studying the relationship between network structure and performance in the context of other emergent *network modalities*. The second introduces a theory of *network bounding* and examines formalization as a key strategy through which organizations can design better networks for collective performance.
