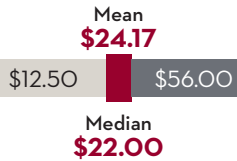

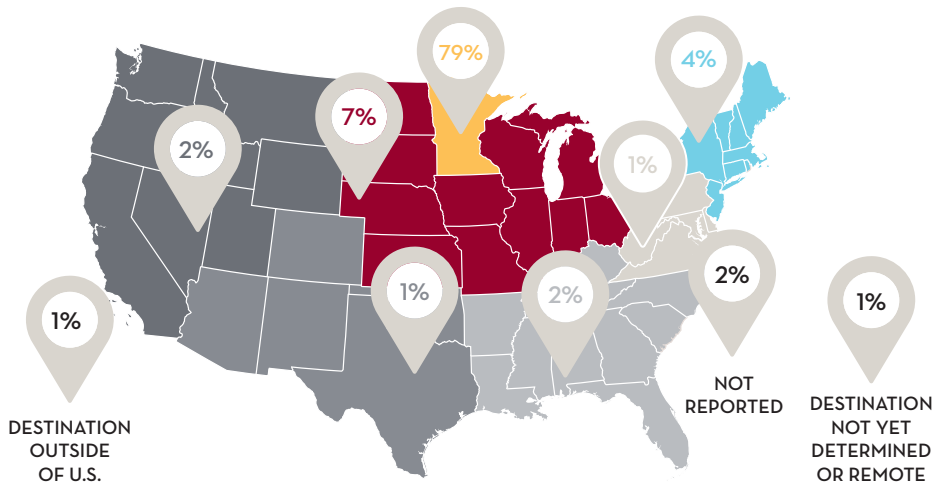

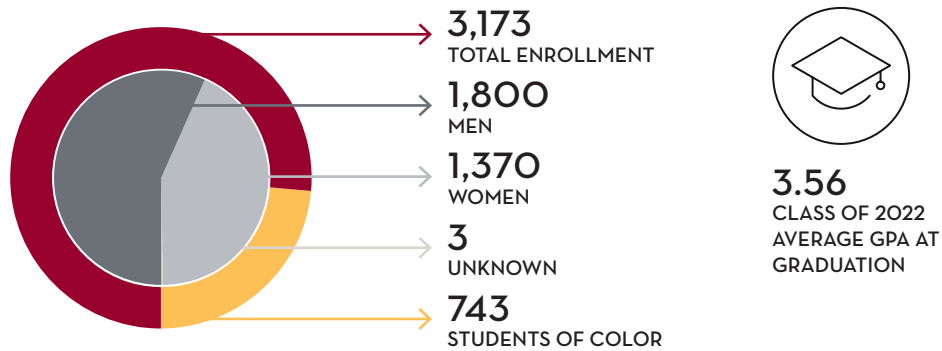

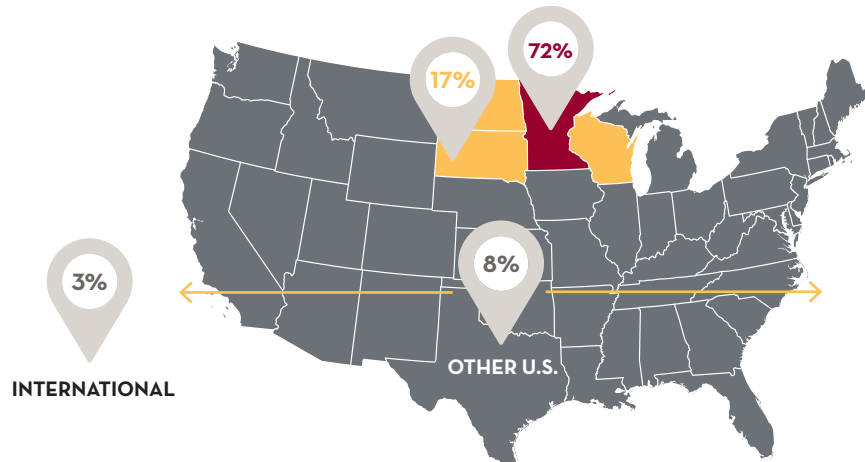
2021-2022 ACADEMIC YEAR
